

Boondall Figure Ice Skating Club Terms and Conditions, Revised December 2010

- 1.** The club relies on parent volunteers to meet its staffing needs. Therefore, all club member families are strongly encouraged to volunteer service for the club each year. Sign-up sheets for the various events - competitions, fund raising, and other activities will be posted at the rink. You will be contacted by a committee chairman or volunteer coordinator for specific volunteer assignments. If you would like to help but have a special situation, such as need to volunteer only during certain hours, please contact the volunteer coordinator for the event.
- 2.** Minimum volunteer requirements for each skater 10 years and older is 2 hrs of service to the club during each of its annual competitions or fundraisers.
- 3.** Minimum volunteer requirements for each parent of a BFISC Junior Member are 4 hours of service to the club during each of its annual events.
- 4.** All items associated with operating the club (such as but not limited to printer/copier, office supplies, website, exhibitions, annual awards, additional equipment and incentive payments when competing interstate and internationally) must be covered through fundraisers. THEREFORE, all club members are encouraged to participate in club fund-raising activities so that membership fees and competition fees will not have to be raised to cover operational costs.
- 5.** All members must keep their membership dues current. BFISC membership runs Jan 1st – Dec 31st every year. Skaters must be current financial members to participate in any competition and/or test sessions. In addition, competition fees, test fees, ice fees, and any other monies paid or payable for skating costs to BFISC, Ice Skating Queensland or any other Australian club must be paid up to date.
- 6.** All club members must agree to abide by the Rules of Skating Etiquette. These can be found at the BFISC website.

Senior Membership

Shall be at least 18 years of age. They shall have the right to vote, hold office and enjoy all privileges and activities of the BFISC.

Junior Membership

The member shall be under the age of 18. They shall enjoy all privileges and activities of the BFISC.

Dues: \$60.00 first family member plus parent/gardian/ \$45.00 per additional family members.

Ability to participate in all club sanctioned events, such as competitions, tests, exhibitions etc.
